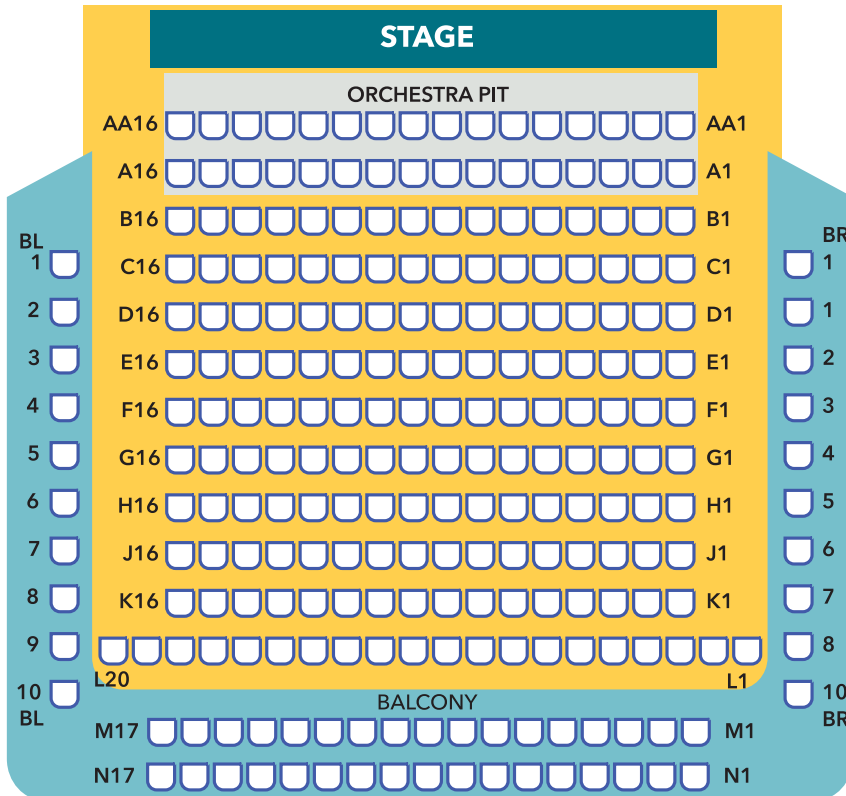

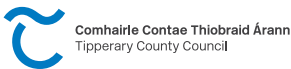

Concessions for Bealtaine events in May

Wonder Walls for Cruinniú na nÓg is back at The Source for 2026 and invites young people aged 12–18 years to take part in a bold, hands-on **street art experience** as part of Cruinniú's nationwide celebration of creativity.

Across two artist-led workshops on **Saturdays April 25th and May 9th** participants will collaborate to design and create a large-scale mural, building real spray-paint skills and working as a creative team. This year, each location including Thurles will also contribute to a special national artwork piece, connecting young people across Ireland in one shared creative moment on Cruinniú na nÓg.

The same group will attend both workshop dates, so availability for both sessions is essential. (If you don't secure a workshop place, don't worry, you can join us on **Saturday June 6th** for open drop-in sessions and be part of the action!) Spaces are limited and can be booked via email only to: admin@sourcearts.ie

Wonder Walls is delivered by The Walls Project, the team behind the Waterford Walls Street Art Festival, and funded by Creative Ireland.

In August, dancers **Alexandre Iseli and Murielle Elizéon** will be working on a new duet **'Tremors'** as part of a **residency at the Source Arts Centre**. Choreographer, dancer, dance curator Alexandre is director of The Tipperary Dance Festival and Murielle is a choreographer, dancer, community weaver and co-director of Culture Mill, a Performing Arts Laboratory based in the US. The in-development **'Tremors'** is described as **"a call to embrace vulnerability at different stages of our lives."**

Evoking the forces of tectonic plates, it is a search for spontaneous joy and unexpected sensations. Tremors imagines dance as a communal, attentive practice: redemption through presence and listening."



'Every novel is the wreck of a perfect idea' or so said author Iris Murdoch. With that in mind, writer **Mary Morrissy is delivering an in-person workshop** at the Source on **Saturday, May 16th**. Entitled **'Biography of an Idea'** and part of the Irish Writers Centre Writers in the Regions programme. Morrissy will examine how a novel grows out of the triggering idea, from the first stirrings of inspiration to writing 'THE END' at the bottom of the manuscript.

A member of Aosdána, Mary Morrissy is the author of four novels and three collections of stories.

Following a sold-out tour last year Niall Breslin, known to many as Bressie, comes to The Source with The Polaris Quartet, as part of a tour to celebrate the recent release of 'The Place That Has Never Been Wounded', his spacious, introspective new album.

The tour continues a presentation that has emerged as one of the most distinctive offerings in the contemporary Irish music landscape.

Built around Breslin's cinematic compositions, the performances unfold as a fully integrated live work. Music, spoken word, and visual design, are interwoven throughout, with lighting and imagery responding in real time to the players on stage. Rather than

functioning as accompaniment, the visual elements shape the pacing and emotional contours of each performance, drawing the audience into a shared, concentrated space.

Audiences are asked to step away from external noise and into an environment designed for presence and release.

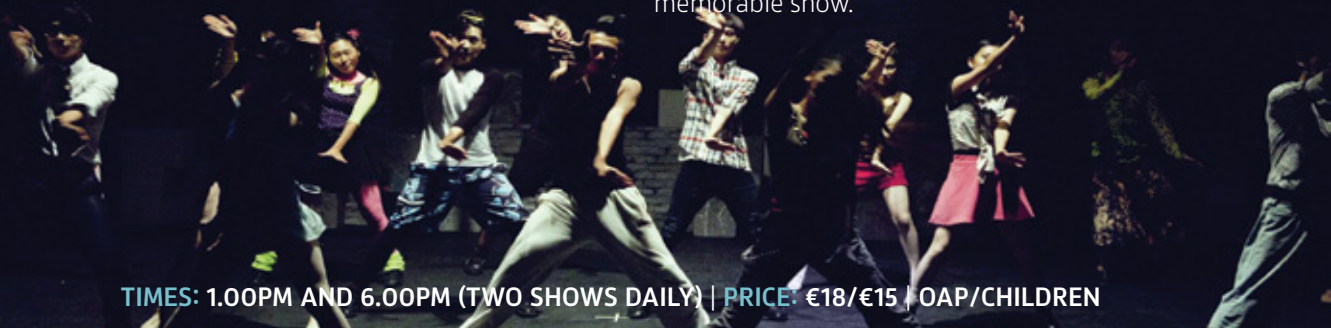

'The Song Cycle', the new film from Nick Kelly, the acclaimed musician (The Fat Lady Sings) and film maker ('The Drummer and the Keeper'), is a documentary film that follows Nick's journey as he undertakes to cycle from Ireland to the Glastonbury Festival while performing along the way.
